GOAL 1: INCREASE ECONOMIC SELF-SUFFICIENCY OF PWD

Objective 1.1: Increase Employment for PWD

Action Step 1.1.1: Advocate for work incentives with employers, public partners & policy makers

Action Step 1.1.2: Provide education on available work incentives

Action Step 1.1.3: Increase utilization of work incentives

Action Step 1.1.4: Increase employability of PWD (including peer mentorships, internships & IL Skills

Objective 1.2: Increase Financial Assets

Action Step 1.2.1: Advocate for increased asset limits (ABLE Accts, Medicaid eligibility)

Action Step 1.2.2: Provide IL skills training to increase financial literacy

GOAL 2: INCREASE INDEPENDENCE

Objective 2.1: Increase the influence of PWD in the community

Action Step 2.1.1: Build & expand community partnerships

Action Step 2.1.2: Provide leadership & self-advocacy skills training to PWD

Objective 2.2: Promote an inclusive community

Action Step 2.2.1: Promote UD in public and private facilities (access surveys, home mods, etc.)

Action Step 2.2.2: Advocate for the enforcement of policies and regulations that support people with disabilities.

Action Step 2.2.3: Advocate for accessible/affordable housing

Action Step 2.2.4: Advocate for accessible affordable transportation

Objective 2.3: Impact Public Policy to support people with disabilities

Action Step 2.3.1: increase the # of PWD who vote (access to polling sites, voter registration, increase # of PWD on permanent disability voting registration, etc)

Action Step 2.3.2: Increase the # of PWD in public policy roles

Action Step 2.3.3: Increase the # of PWD & partners participating in the legislative process.

Action Step 2.3.4: Advocate for policies & programs that support the I.L. Philosophy (ex: long-term care supports, HCBS, etc.)

GOAL 3: INCREASE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FOR PWD

Objective 3.1: Ensure access to disability specific emergency planning and preparedness resources.

Action Step 3.1.1: Identify and/or implement materials in various formats to develop an organizational emergency plan to ensure that staff members and volunteers are fully prepared to facilitate communication in the event of an emergency and that offices, including consumer information, are well protected in the event of an emergency.

Activity 3.1.2: Identify and/or implement materials in various formats for use by CILs or other service providers to educate people with disabilities about being prepared in a disaster. This may include information for consumers that increases their knowledge regarding access to available services during and after a disaster as well as information on preparedness, such as how to make an emergency plan and kit.

Objective 3.2: The SILC and its Emergency Management Committee build disability inclusion into all aspects of emergency management through partnerships with local, state and federal emergency management.

Activity 3.2.1: Locate and or develop, if necessary, an annual work plan collaborating with federal, state, and local agencies to coordinate, educate and conduct outreach efforts regarding emergency preparedness.

Activity 3.2.2: Ensure that the State Emergency Preparedness Plan is inclusive of people with disabilities by becoming actively involved in local and state emergency management.

Activity 3.2.3: Provide disability-related input to the State Emergency Management Division and to other county or local governmental and non-governmental agencies (e.g., VOADs, Red Cross, Salvation Army, faith based organizations) responsible for emergency preparedness and response.

Activity 3.2.4: To promote independent living participation in local and state emergency planning, preparedness and response activities such as work groups and task forces developed to address emergency management and response.

GOAL 4: INCREASE THE CAPACITY OF THE SILC

Objective 4.1: Identify resources needed to fulfill the expanded role of the SILC

Action Step 4.1.1: Hire designated staff to work in conjunction with the SILC, CIL and DSE.

Action Step 4.1.2: Develop and implement an annual resource/action plan.
